Payment Options

Prompt Payment Discounts available:

Annual payment – less 10% if paid prior to membership expiry/ less 7.5% if paid within 30 days of membership expiry

Half yearly – less 5%/ Quarterly – less 2.5% (All half yearly, quarterly and monthly fees must be paid by direct debit to credit card or cheque/savings account)

Pay by Mail

Payment may be made by cheque, credit card or money order by completing the Remittance Advice attached to your renewal and forwarding it to CMA, P O Box 424, Eltham, VIC 3095

Pay by Fax

Payment may be made by MasterCard or Visa by completing the Remittance Advice attached to your renewal and forwarding it by facsimile to 03 8640 0474.
